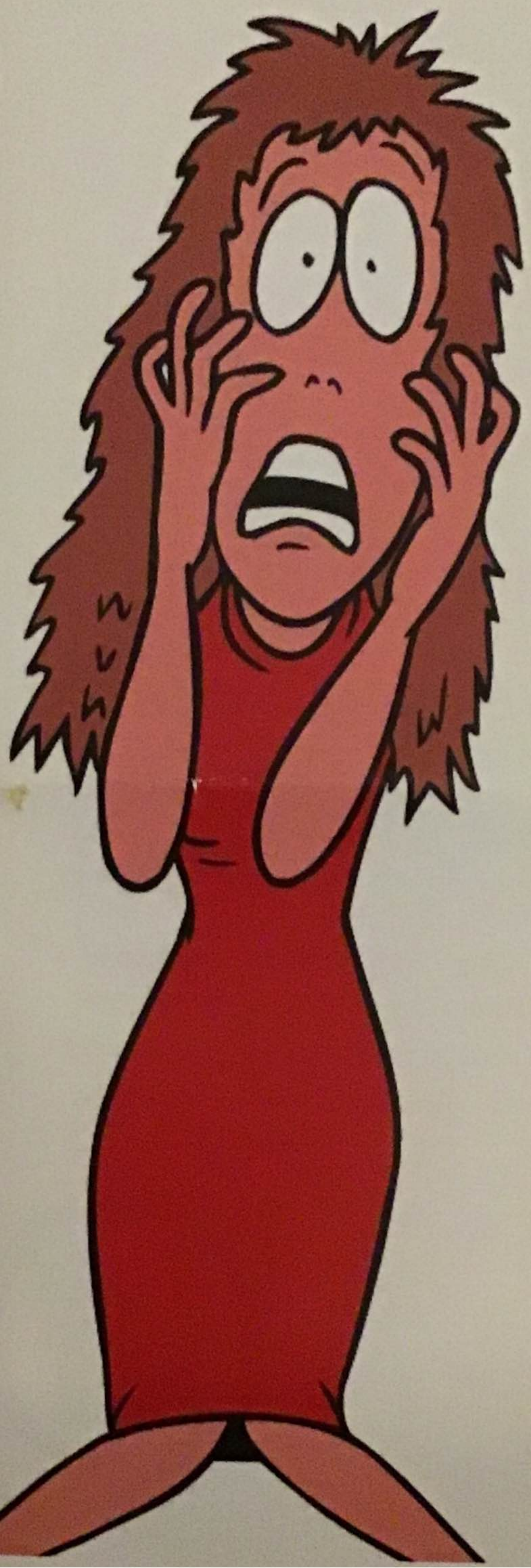
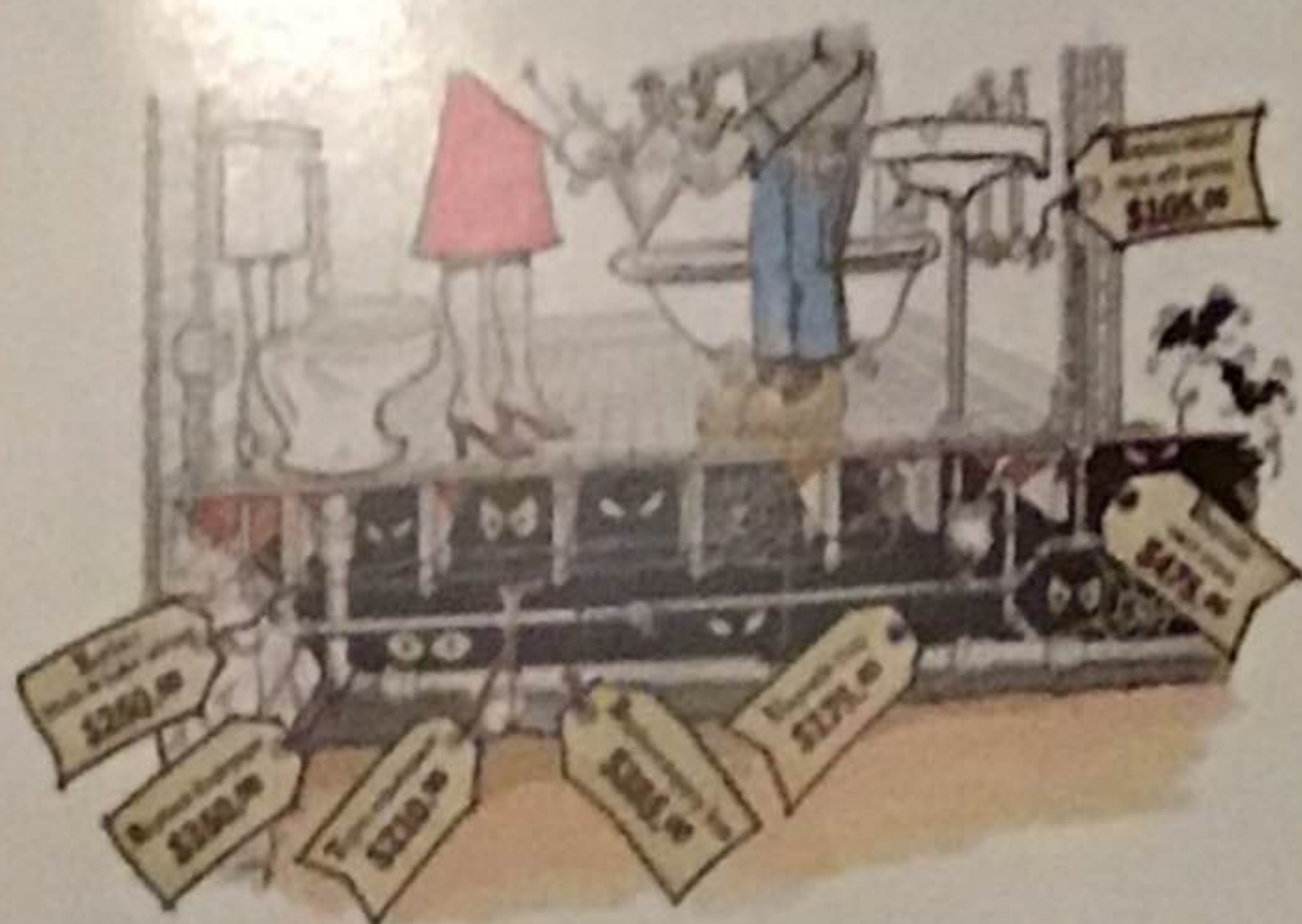

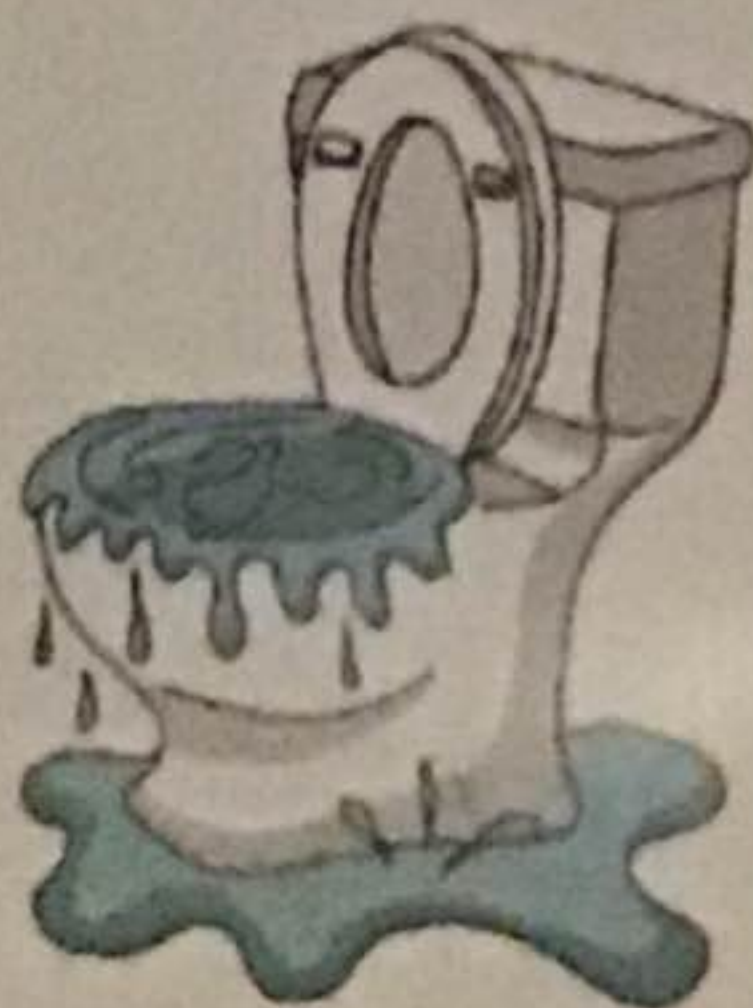


You can avoid expensive plumbing problems, protect public health and keep our water clean.



HOW TO AVOID A COSTLY CLOG?

Don't flush any types of wipes down the commode. Foods and F.O.G can cling to them and build up more quickly in wastewater pipes

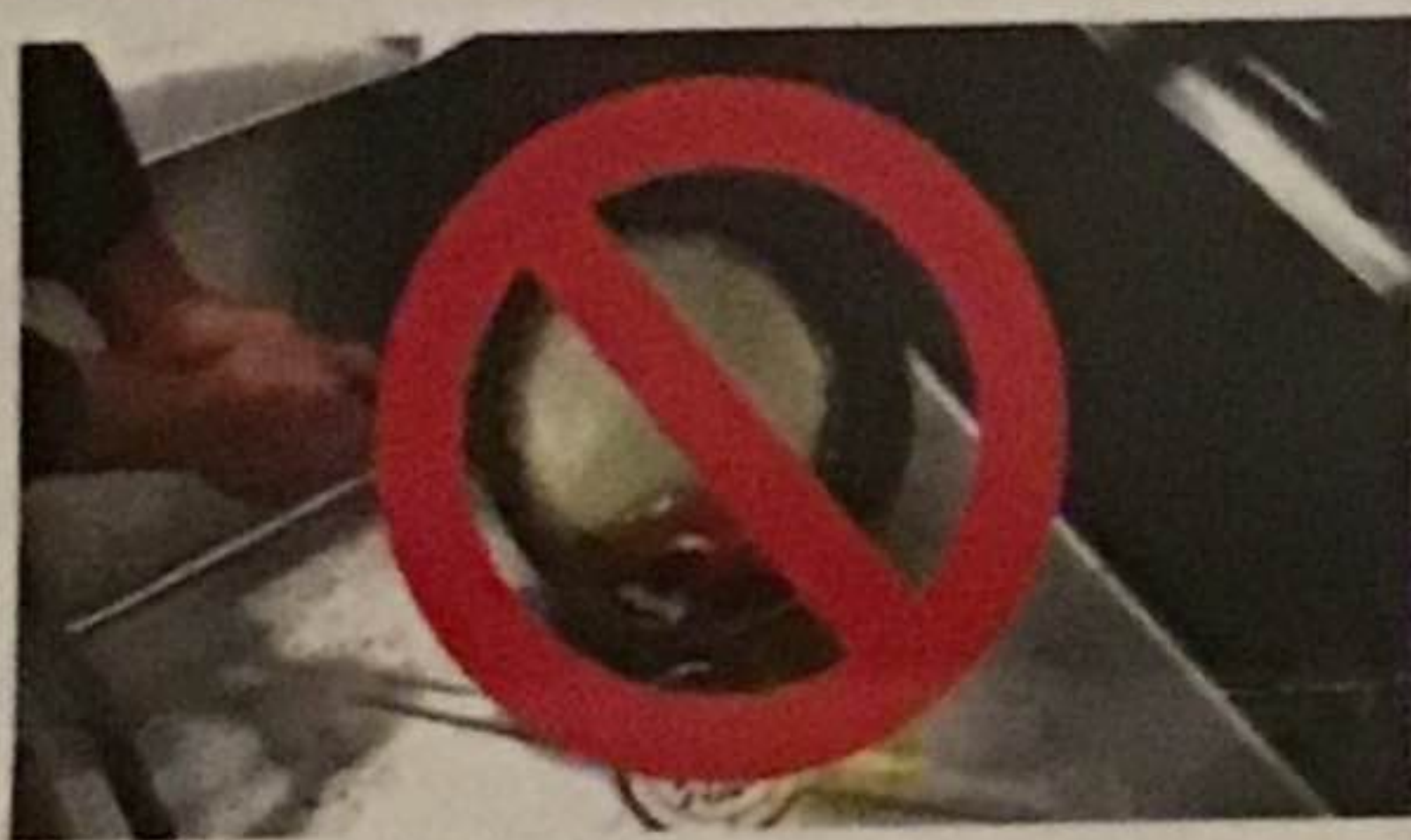

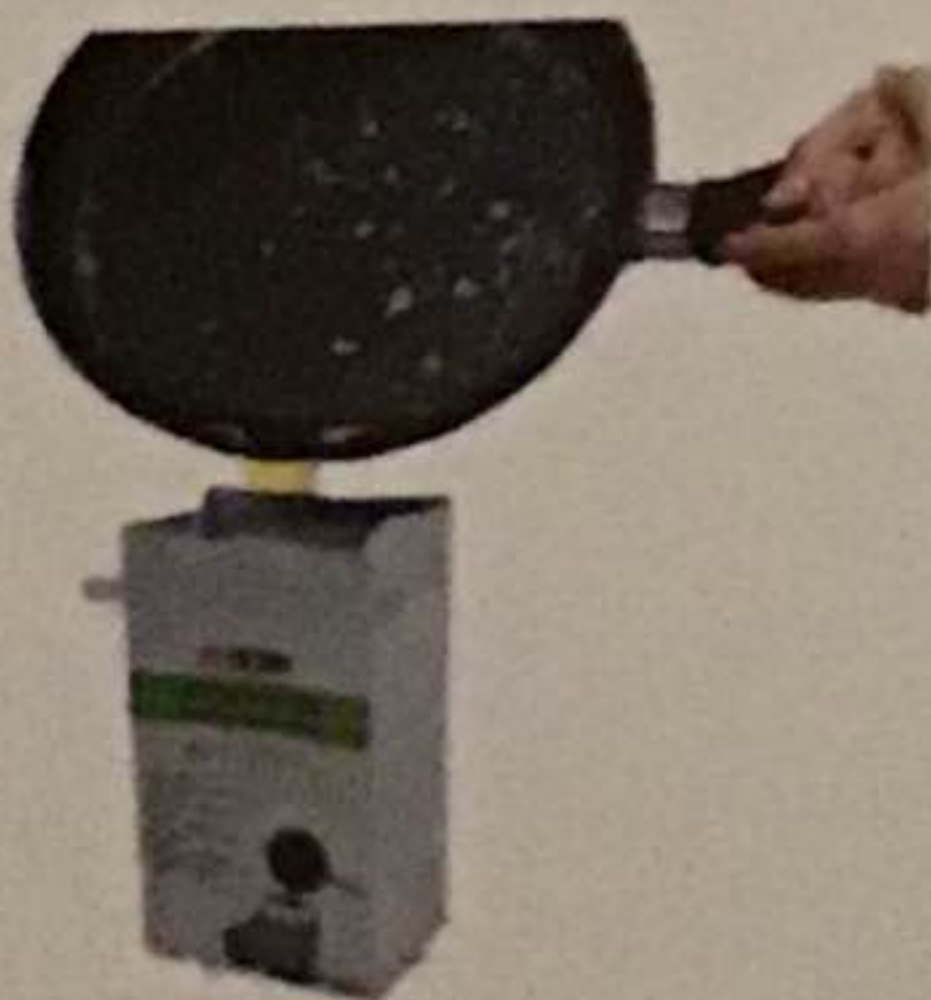
Fats, Oils and Grease



Don't run water over dishes or cookware to wash oil or grease down the sink.



Don't pour cooking oil, pan drippings, gravy, bacon grease, lard, etc. down the sink or toilet



FAT TRAPPER BAGS

Did you know you can responsibly dispose of FOG with grease trap bags? Prevent costly plumbing repairs by disposing of your grease properly.

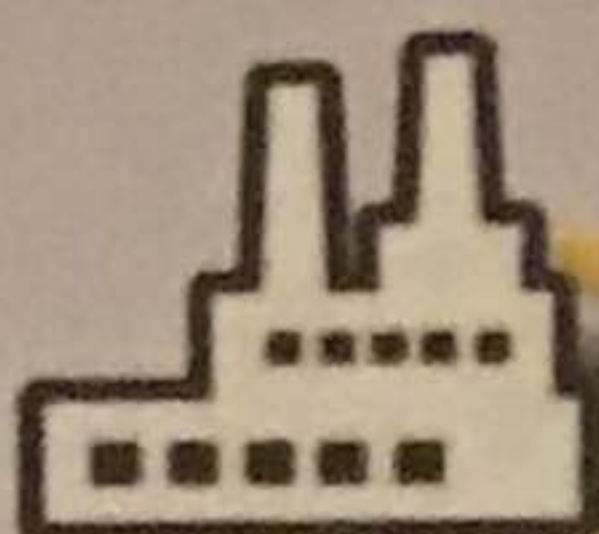
